POSITION DESCRIPTION:

- Greeting the guest promptly of their entering the sales area and determining their needs.
- Providing product information and assisting customers with selection.
- Ensuring that all sales are quickly and accurately transacted.
- Safeguarding Reading Terminal Market Retail Shop assets at all times.
- Abiding by all cash and credit card handling procedures.
- Ensuring that the guest is treated with courtesy and respect.
- Maintaining a clean and organized sales floor at all times.
- Reviewing inventory to ensure that all shelves and fixtures are filled with product (including all size runs of apparel) at all times.
- Demonstrating knowledge of products and services to guests.

Experience:
